

Foot of Solding Hill. I am told that the Waters of Potowmack are taken  
for Canoes to go up loaded & there are but 13 Canoes in the River now &  
it is impossible to get any made at this time. These Canoes being at the Mouth  
of Seneca Creek I shall send off a Party of Militia for them early in the  
Morning & as soon as they come to this Place they shall be loaded with about  
half the Stores that were brought hither yesterday from Carlyle & will be  
sent to the Old Town which is as far as they will be able to go & it will take  
them 3 Days to inform it. I shall order three Officers & 20 Men of the Mary.  
& Penn Militia & a Captain in the Bridgeman's Regt with twenty  
Men of Capt. Jenkins' Detachment to convey them up. I shall order Capt.  
Dagworthy to begin to clear the Road from Fort Cumberland to the Old Town  
as he is too weak to spare many Men for that Service especially as  
he must immediately on the arrival of the Canoes at the Old Town or the  
Gates come down a strong Party to receive them & to convey them to Fort  
Cumberland which for I understand that he will not be able at any rate  
to make up more than three or four teams there will be no easy Task.  
From what I have heard I do not expect the Carolina Troops here these  
next Days. When Major Hille comes I shall order him to clear the  
Road between the Old Town and Solding Hill. It'll Probs. not be able  
upon the Credit of Mr. Kelly's Letter to get many of his Friends to  
purchase Provisions for any Troops that may be ordered this way, however  
under a Receipt of pay down the County for a few Days, but that will  
not make any difference.

To Capt. Dagworthy. Fort Frederick the 23<sup>rd</sup> of June 1750.  
Sir - Since the Date of this comes one Adam McCarry who has my Order  
to apply to you for an Ax or a cutting Tool & then to blaze a Rod with the  
Ax & dispatch from Fort Cumberland to the Solder Hill Cabin, as soon as he has  
made Report to you of his having so done. You are to have a good Head gun  
with the greatest Conveniency by way of Encouragement to the Party that you  
may order in this Service to assist themselves if you are compelled to allow them a  
small quantity of Ale or other Spirituous Liquor for which it will be best to  
order payment to be made in about a Day after my next word is said.
