

In Council Annapolis 8<sup>th</sup> March 1778.

Sir,  
The scarcity of Clothing for the Soldier, makes it desirable to get Cloths  
dressed or undressed; if undressed the Price ought to be in Proportion and we  
No. III. can, if necessary get it finished or at least forwarded, so as to make it more  
useful. We shall be obliged to you to transmit us an Account of the Blankets  
furnished (Col<sup>o</sup> Richardson), with his Receipt, that they may be charged  
to the Continent. Any Clothing you have collected or may be fortunate  
enough to obtain, be pleased to send us: and an Answer with those which  
have been collected in Somerset & Worcester ~~forwards~~ which are in Mr.  
Stevens Hands and which we now write to him to send. We have  
no Idea that the Commiss<sup>r</sup> allowed is a Matine with you or any other  
Gent<sup>r</sup> to do this Business for the Publick and wish it was in our  
Power and the Inclin<sup>r</sup> of Gent<sup>r</sup> in General to make the Burthen  
more equal by a fair Division of it, but you may be assured we  
are too often unsuccessful in our Appointments.

Sir,  
Mr. Steamaker, on his Return, has called on us and gives us such  
Information of the Number & Situation of the Ships that we imagine  
113. there will be no immediate Attempt to run the Virginia: indeed we  
think the chance of getting through so small, that we wish you not  
to make a Push, if your Orders give you any latitude. Our Sentim<sup>r</sup>  
on the Subject have already been mentioned to some of the Gent<sup>r</sup>  
of the Congress. The Defence's Tender & the Platow have been con-  
stantly employed in the Service of the Congress and are like to be so:  
we also want the Dolphin, chiefly for the same Purpose & request  
you'll send her down to us. —
