Your Letter of the 07th Inst: we have received. If the Orders on the
Collectors are not paid and the People will not take Certificates, it
will answer no good Purpose to continue your Purchases, from an
Expectation of obtaining an adequate Supply of Money from us; for
360. our Treasury is empty, and we are destitute of the Means of filling
it, nor can we say when it will be in our Power to furnish our
Commissaries with Money to enable them to execute the Law; but
if you had it, we think you ought not to exceed the Limitations
mentioned in our former Letter, because we are certain that a
Sufficient Quantity of Wheat and Flour can be procured on the
Western Shore at those Prices
