We were honored with your Letter of the 7th Instant and
have the Pleasure to inform your Excellency that the General officers
bly have passed a Law to raise two Battalions of Militia to
be composed of thirteen hundred and forty effective Men in-
cluding now Commissioned Officers to bear until the 10th Day of
December next. The State of Maryland sensible that it is of the
599 utmost Importance to check the further Progress of the enemy and
to repel them from every Part of the united States are determined
to make every possible exertion for the succour of the State of
Virginia, and to reinforce the Army under Genl Green.
They have appropriated £ 200,000 to be immediately struck on
British confiscated and forfeited Property aided by private
Subscriptions and Associations to the sole Purpose of carrying
on the present Campaign with unmitting Vigour, and we
flatter ourselves such is the spirit of the people here, and their
Opinion of the expediency of driving the enemy from the continent
that nothing will be left undone that can be accomplished.
The militia as good as they are raised and equipped shall be
marched away by Detachments in the Manner your Excellency
has advised; we have ordered three Volunteer Troops of
Militia light Horse about Seventy in Number to join
the Virginis and expect they are with him by this time.
