You will forward the Cattle to this Place as soon as possible in Drouves not less than twenty Head at a Time, to enable you to expedite this Business you will receive this Opportunity forty Pounds of the new Emision, which is to be paid as Specie and only for Expenses incurred since the 19th Day of June last.
