In Council 30th. August 1781

No 707. A Detachment from the Main Army, with the French Troops, to the Number of 7000 men will be at the Head of Elk in eight Days, on their Way to Virginia to act against Lord Cornwallis. General Washington has wrote very presingly for an immediate and large Supply of fresh Provisions; we therefore direct you to procure by Purchase Buffaloe (preferring those Parts of your County which are most exposed to the Ravage of the Enemy; and in case the Owners will not consent to sell them upon the Terms prescribed by the Act for procuring an immediate Supply of Cloathing & Cloth Provisions you will seize them agreeably to the said Act. You will also purchase all the Bacon, barrelled Pork and Beef in your County, if not to be purchased, you will seize what can be spared without distressing the Owners, agreeably to the Act to procure a Supply of Salt Meat &c. passed June 1780.
