Having in obedience to an act of Assembly passed at the last Session, appointed William Kilty Esq to attend the Sales of property taken in execution to satisfy the claims of the State, and to purchase the same for the use of the State, if a Sale cannot otherwise be effected so as to secure a reasonable price for the property so taken it becomes our further duty to take such measures as may insure the full execution of the intention of the Legislature in this particular - As the duty of the said Agent and of others whom in the progress of the business we may appoint will be interwoven with that of the several Sheriffs and as the due execution of his trust will require the ready concurrence and assistance of the said Sheriffs we have thought proper to direct by this our Circular letter that
