Sir

We have sent an Express to the Sheriff of
Charles to postpone the Sale of the Executors property, un-
til further orders, and have directed him to call upon
you that in case you should have already given
directions he may return. We take this step in conformity
to a Resolution of the House of Delegates which directs
that all further proceedings in virtue of the Act under
which you had your appointment be suspended until
97 the present General Assembly shall take further order
We have wrote to the Sheriffs of Harford and St.
Marys to postpone the Sales in those Counties, and
we request you not to dispose of any property you
have purchased on behalf of the State, the personal
property excepted, which we would have you dispose
of under our former directions. of the Slaves if
you can get as much as you gave for them
and of the other personal property for what you
can get.
