

Circular, In Council May 5 1790
Sir,

Agreeably to the directions of an Act to regulate the inspection of Tobacco passed last Session of a Assembly, we enclose you a list of the names of the several Inspectors in this State and their respective Warehouses annexed.

138. By the said Act we are empowered to draw orders in your favor for the sum of one penny for every hoghead of Tobacco inspected in virtue of said Act, and shipped from your district which will be done upon your complying on your part with the directions of the Law.

We also request your attention to an Act passed November Session 1781. Chap 12 to prevent the exportation of Bread and Flour not merchantable and to an Act passed at November Session 1786 Chap 17. for the inspection of Salted Provisions
