Gentlemen,

To avoid further delay in the appointment
of Inspectors for your County, we have considered your letter
of the 25th Ult^o as a renewal of the recommendation made
in Jan^y 1790; according to which we have re-appointed
those who officiated during that year, which is all that is
necessary with respect to them; and have directed Commission
to issue to John Bruce for Cedar point Ignatius
Ryan for Nanjemoy; Hezekiah Garner for Chathamson
and Francis Wheatley of John for Benedict Warehouse
but as we have been at a loss to understand your intentions
we would recommend a stricter attention in future to
the directions of the Act, and of the Supplement passed
last Session concerning your duty in this particular.
