Guineas for the services required of you in ours of the
27th instant, provided the expenditures amount to one

23. thousand seven hundred and fifty pounds, and in
that proportion should they not amount to, or exceed
that sum, that is at the rate of ten per cent on all
the monies expended in the repairs, the Commission
