Sir,

In consequence of our application to the
Governor of Delaware under the article of the
Constitution of the United States, John Legate one
of the persons charged by the grand Jury of
Worcester, with the murder of John Harman
63 has been arrested and is now in the custody of
the Sheriff of Sussex County in that State ready
to be delivered to our order. You are therefore
required forthwith to repair either in person or
by Deputy to the Sheriff of Sussex County in
Delaware and to receive from him the aforesaid
John Legate and him so received immediately to
convey to the Goal of your County and there keep
him in close and safe custody to be dealt with
according to Law
As it is proper that the State of
Maryland should pay to the Sheriff of Sussex, all
reasonable expences incurred by, and all fees due
to him in consequence of the arrest and imprisonment
