

include or extend to the regulation of the police
of towns, we cannot take any measures for
the restraining disorderly people, nor can those
who have this power, make any regulations to
affect strangers in distinction from other persons.
We do not doubt however that an application
to the Justices of the Criminal Court of Baltimore
will be productive of all necessary precautions
and regulations in that town, if the present ones
should not be sufficient - No french vessels have
as yet arrived here - should any come to this
place we shall require lists of their passengers
to be made out and when obtained shall forward
them to you - We are &c
