

purpose of opposing the legally constituted au-
-thorities at St Domingo - he has reason to
believe the information to be unfounded, at least
so far as it supposes Baltimore to be the
center of such a combination. - It is true
that numbers of frenchmen and particularly
the soldiers, have been sent to the Northward
and that the vessels of war are likewise gone
from Baltimore, to join as it is supposed,
the french Squadron off New York - but it is
unnecessary to repeat the conjectures made at
Baltimore on this subject, as the designs of the
french force on the coast must certainly be better
understood by the General Government than by
private individuals. Capt. Kelly however en-
-quired of the french Vice Consul respecting
the supposed combination and armament against
St Domingo; and was answered categorically
that no such thing existed -

Here ends Capt. Kelly's report which
indisposition has prevented him from making

have manifested by this measure will operate
