89. declined any immediate interference on the  
Letters received from the french Consul and  
yourself and recommended an application to  
him. — Under the Circumstances represented  
to us there can be no doubt that speedy and  
vigorous measures ought to be adopted to se-  
cure the peace and safety of Baltimore, as  
well as to prevent improper combinations  
against the french Republic — And so far  
as this Board with the assistance of the  
Governor can consider themselves authorized
