

Annapolis September 12. 1793

Gentlemen,

Your communication with the report
of The Physicians on the danger of an inter-
-and intercourse with Philadelphia has been
taken into immediate consideration and with
the concurrence of the Council, I have issued
90 the proclamation herewith enclosed which I
flatter myself will meet your wishes and
have the desired effect. I commit to you the
charge of having it published, and likewise
that of filling up the Blanks for the two
Officers, which I imagine you can do more
beneficially than the Board can; and you
will please to do it privately.

I shall be indebted to you for information
respecting proper persons to be appointed
above Baltimore and hope you will suggest
any measures that may seem calculated to
