the Union have set us the example by mak-
-ing subscriptions in Trust precisely similar,
to the present.

We beg leave in conclusion to
suggest that as the Stock produced by the
Subscription stands at present on the Commission-
-ers Books in the name of Mr. William
Marbury to whom the other Gentlemen whose
names were made use of have transferred, and
by whom Interest has already been received
and lodged in the Treasury to the amount of
10,823 Dollars and twenty one Cents, it may
be proper for the General Assembly to make
some Arrangements as to its future
Management, We presume that it must
be held by some person in Trust for the
State, and that the Trustees responsibility ought
to be attended to. - At present Government
has no other Security but the Integrity of the
Agent who has been employed; nor was it
heretofore practicable to obtain any other from
the nature of the business and the manner in
which it was necessary to conduct it -
