We have the Honour to transmit to you the enclosed copy of an Act of the General Assembly of this State entitled "An Act to appoint a Health Officer for the Port of Baltimore Town in Baltimore County," the operation of which, as you will observe on a perusal of it, depends on the consent of Congress being obtained to the imposition of a Tonnage Duty as mentioned in the latter part of the Act in the procuring of which, the General Assembly request your assistance.
