you are hereby instructed safely to convey to such place at or near the
Division line between this State and the State of Delaware and at such
Times as shall be prescribed by his Excellency the Governor of the said State
of Delaware the persons arrested by you in Virtue of our Warrant of the
8th Day of December last and returned indorsed by you as follows to wit
In obedience to the Tenor of the within Writ, Williams Andrew and Thomas Smith
residents in Caroline County have been apprehended, and are now in
my Custody, ready to be delivered to whoever may be legally authorised
to receive them: The other persons named in the Writ are not in Caroline
County. -

and the said Williams Andrew and Thomas Smith so conveyed to deliver
into the Custody of such officer or other person as the Governor of the said
State of Delaware shall direct in order for their Trial for the offences
wherewith they are charged as in the said Warrant is recited. - and
you will hereafter make known to me with all convenient Despatch
how you have executed these Instructions
