I take the liberty of enclosing to you a copy of a Letter which I have
received from the Secretary of State by which you will perceive that
the President of the United States has directed me that as often as a
fleet Squadron or Ship of any belligerent Nation shall clearly and
unequivocally use the Rivers or other waters of Maryland as a Station
in order to carry on Hostile expeditions from thence that I shall cause to
be notified to the Commander thereof that the President deems such conduct
to be contrary to the rights of our Neutrality. to carry into effect this direction
I request you if any Vessel should use such a Station for the purpose
mentioned in the Letter of the Secretary of State within the jurisdiction
of the State of Maryland on the Eastern Shore that you will cause
the Commander thereof to be notified of these Instructions and
immediately thereafter communicate the same to the Secretary
of State - and send to me a copy of such communication.
