

It is intended, in the acquisition of the arms only. There seems to be
 great a view in storing the arms and Powder in the same House, we would
 think best you to procure some house, for the Powder if it can be effected
 without expence as a house as is the powder except fifty half barrels
 will be easily done, if we conceive that a small house may be had
 for less expence, if this should not be the case, the Powder must be
 stored in the arms until the Legislature shall direct the building
 of a magazine for that purpose.
