In Council Annapolis November the 19/1800

Sir,

Having received information, that a certain William Martin of Baltimore County, charged with feloniously stealing sundry goods the property of James Lyle, within the jurisdiction of this State, to wit, at the City of Baltimore; and also that a certain James Edgar of Baltimore County charged with feloniously stealing sundry goods the property of James Holmes within the jurisdiction of this State, to wit, at the City of Baltimore; and also that a certain Peter Ferrar of Baltimore County charged with feloniously stealing sundry goods the property of John Holmes, within the jurisdiction of this State, to wit, at the City of Baltimore; and that the said William Martin, James Edgar and Peter Ferrar, have fled from justice to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and are now severally confined in jail in the City of Philadelphia. We therefore in the name of the Executive authority of the State of Maryland, demand of your Excellency, that the said William Martin, James Edgar and Peter Ferrar, be delivered up to James Wilson, who is appointed the agent of the Executive authority of the State of Maryland to receive the said William Martin, James Edgar and Peter Ferrar, and remove them to this State.

For your Excellency's satisfaction we do ourselves the honor to transmit to you an official transcript of the several indictments against the said William Martin, James Edgar and Peter Ferrar, and this application is founded.
