Sir,

Agreeable to the intimation contained in your Letter of the 23 of June last I
have now enclosed a Statement made by the Treasurer of the Western Shore of
Maryland of the Interest due on the 1st of July instant, on the two Loans of one
hundred thousand Dollars each made by this State for the use of the City of
Washington; who is authorized by law to receive and give acquittances for all
Monies due to the State... It will be most convenient for the purposes of this
Treasury to receive the Money in the Bank of Deposit of Baltimore. The
usual mode of transmitting to the Treasurer here: a Warrant for the amount
on that Bank, the receipt of which he will acknowledge, will probably best
answer the object; however any other form that may be deemed expedient will be
complied with, when designated.

Information having been received by the Executive of this State, that a certain
Newell Watton on the second Instant, did (within the Jurisdiction of Maryland)
take into his possession as Slaves three Sumner Natives of the East Indies and did
forcibly carry the said Sumner as his Slaves into Caroline County in the Common-
wealth of Virginia, and that the said Newell Watton is at present in Potomac
County in the Commonwealth aforesaid... We have therefore thought it
