Council Chamber Annapolis January 27 1803

By a Resolution of the General Assembly of Maryland the Executive are authorized to purchase from  
thousand Stand of Arms and Ammunition. By the act of Congress of fourteen hundred and eighty eight the Governor  
is authorized to purchase thirty thousand Stand of Arms for the purpose of their being distributed to the respective States. I have therefore to request of you such information as to the Arms under this act in the possession of  
the President as will satisfy us whether we can be supplied with the quantity we are authorized to purchase. Will  
you inform us of their quality and say at what price. Your answer will oblige you

In Council Annapolis March 9 1803

Sir

Information has been received by the Executive of this State that a certain James Brown is now  
confined in the Gaol at Philadelphia in the State of Pennsylvania, who has been indicted in the  
Court of Oyer and Terminer and Gaol Delivery for Baltimore County for forgery. We have therefore  
thought proper in the name of the Executive Authority of the State of Maryland to demand of  
your Excellency the said James Brown as a fugitive from Justice agreeably to the act of Congress  
thereto relating, and that he be delivered to George Dultra whom we have appointed Agent to  
receive the said James Brown and to remove him to this State. For your Excellency's satisfaction  
we have enclosed an authenticated copy of the Indictment on which this application is grounded.
