In Council Annapolis March 5 1809

Your letter of the 27th of September last found in the Council Chamber on my arrival here a few days since. It has since been in the Library and has since been of laying before the Council and was approved by the Council. The Return of your Receipt enclosed to me in General Frazier's letter of the 27th of August was laid before the Board on Wednesday the 10th of September and was approved and ordered to be because the Return was made in as much as necessary a manner as recommended. This question also arose on the 11th of September when it was heard that Mr. Loman held a Commission for the same purpose. Mr. Loman's Commission could have also been returned on the 10th of September if Mr. Loman was laid before the Council on the 10th of September. It is not in the City since the members of the Council attended at the meeting of the Board on the 10th of September. The irregularity of the Return was not adverted to in the Council and from the fact that it is a true statement of the Commission and although some may have been made in the Council on a Commission of Mr. Loman which is not in the City has induced your order in the present situation.
