Information has been received by the Executive of this State that a certain
David Williams charged with having seduced from the service of their
Master three Negro Boys has fled to the State of Georgia and is
now in the hands of the authorities of that State in the name of the Execu-
tive of this State. It is the duty of your Excellency to cause
the said David Williams to be arrested and brought from Justice
and to be committed to the Gaol of John Howell Square where we
have appointed a Justice of the Peace to hold him and remove him to this
State for your Excellency's satisfaction we have enclosed you an authenticated
Copy of a Warrant on which this application is made. We are &c
