Gentlemen

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the tenth Instant and the sub-  
ject matter thereof has been duly considered by the Executive. It is much to be regretted  
that the Penitentiary should have been left in the situation which you represented it to  
and it would afford to the Executive great pleasure to be able to give any aid, in their power, to-  
wards the removal of its embarrassments. But to authorize a loan, and more especially to  
when the Legislature thought proper to refuse an appropriation is without the limits of  
their authority and any engagement into which the Executive might enter, or assurances  
which they might give would have no binding operation upon the State. Indeed so far  
from facilitating the payment of it by the Legislature, any interference by them would  
rather insure the future settlement of the claim. However just it might appear in itself, yet  
such an interference by them would be an assumption of power, the Legislature would be  
reluctant to pay it when by so doing, a sanction would be given to an unauthorized  
appropriation of Money by the Executive Branch of Government.

As to myself, although I am extremely anxious to go to Somerset for the purpose of attending  
to my private concerns, I would not hesitate a moment in making any personal sacrifice  
could my presence at Baltimore be useful in removing the difficulties with which the  
of Inspectors are at present embarrassed, but as I am not clothed with any official power  
more than any other individual member of the Board of Inspectors, I conceive my attendance  
unnecessary.
