As soon as possible after the meeting of the General Assembly of Maryland we submitted to them your letter requesting the passage of a Bill authorizing the directors of the Baltimore and Annapolis Road. It was not in our power to inform you of the decision of the General Assembly sooner. Today it was determined to reject the Bill, which you had recommended.
