My Dear Sir

I will do myself the pleasure to wait on you in the course of five days with the account. Finding that I could not get the Pay rolls that were delivered to the Pay Masters, I have been for several weeks trying to do something with those I received from the late Accountants. The Pay rolls for the Eastern Shore are very defective and there are a great number missing. It is likely that I may be able to get many of them from the late Accountants. The accounts that were filed with me have been arranged ever since June last, and had the Accountants furnished two Pay rolls as they ought to have done, the account would have been finished months ago.
