November 19. 1777

Ordered that the accounts of
the agents for the collection of the
public arms be settled by the clerk
of the Council on the edges
producing the owners receipts
for the delivery of the arms
actually collected by them at the
following rates it being understood
as well as with the said agents
that the expense of collecting
and transporting said arms
is to be borne by them exclusively
and that the said rates are not
to apply to arms collected in the
City of Baltimore. For each
Musket and Bayonet 1 dollar
A Pair of Pistols & Holsters 1 dollar
