The letters were communicated to the General Assembly of this State by Governors Stone and Mercer but by some accident have been mislaid; you will no doubt find them on the Records of your Department and will I am sure readily comply with my request and by that means particularly oblige one who will at any time feel a great pleasure in recognizing the favour. You will send me a copy of a Resolution which passed the Legislature of Virginia in 1802 on the same subject that is to say the fixing the Western boundary of the States
