Council Chamber Annapolis April 25 1784

The Governor and Council at their last meeting on Saturday last finding that the Laws for the Eastern Shore were still in my possession and understanding that considerable complaints were made in consequence of their not having been transmitted ordered me to forward them for Talbot, Caroline, Dorchester, Worcester and Somerset by Mr. Haddaway. I have therefore to inform you that all the Laws for the Eastern Shore have been sent on. The votes and proceedings will be ready in the course of two or three weeks of which I will give you due notice. In the meantime I should like to hear from you.
