

A Copy of a Letter written to the Pay
sters of the 21st 33rd & 49th Regts May 18th 1819.

Dear Sir 'In consequence of Mr. Merediths not
making out a Duplicate Pay Roll, I was
under the necessity of filing the Muster Rolls as
 vouchers to the account. Mr. Hagner to whom
the account was referred by the Secretary of war,
just informed me, if I could furnish him with
Pay Rolls that it ~~would~~ save him a great deal
trouble and expedite the settlement of our claims.
You would be so good as to enclose all the pay
rolls for the Regiment, under cover to me, by mail,
and take great ~~care~~ care that no injury shall
be done to you, and see that they are safely returned when
Hagner is done with them.
