In consequence of a Resolution which was passed by the Legislature at the last session, placing the collection of the Debts due to the State in the hands of the respective Treasurers, the Executive are of opinion that they have no authority to direct you as to the issuing of the Executions on the Judgments obtained by the State against William Chamberlate Treasurer of the Eastern Shore and Henry Dearden and the Executors of Mr^{rs} Nicholson Securities—
