

Council Chamber Annapolis 21st Feb 1835

Sir
By a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Mayor's Court signed by you, it appears that James Daley (and) John Jones, alias Edward Torrey have been committed to Jail in the State of Pennsylvania on a charge of having stolen a horse, the property of King (and) Bliss of the City of Baltimore, in the State of Maryland. His Excellency the Governor has requested the Honble Judge Price of Baltimore to examine into the case (and) send him a copy of the indictment or affidavit charging them with the felony as the case might be in order to ground a demand of them on the Executive of Pennsylvania under those circumstances it is desirable that they should be retained in confinement until you hear further from me, which will be in the course of a few days. The law of Congress limits the time of confinement to six months from the day of commitment.
