

Council Chamber unopt Augt 27. 1829

Dear Sir If it is desirable that James  
Daley ~~and~~ John Jones alias Edward Dorley  
charged with stealing a horse the property  
of Ling & Bliss of Baltimore should  
be demanded from the Governor of  
Pennsylvania as fugitives from justice  
the Governor thinks, the sooner <sup>it is done</sup> the better,  
as they will be in all probability discharged  
from confinement in Septembers next  
unless a demand is made soon. An  
affidavit made before you, charging them  
with the felony, and transmitted to this  
Department will be sufficient to ground  
an application on. The bringing of fugitives  
from justice from the different States, is  
attended with considerable expense, and  
demands should not be made on trivial  
occasions.
