I will thank you to inform me as soon as convenient ^{of the} the number of swords (and) pikes, that were received by your troops respectively in the years 1813 and 1814. A mistake of forty swords complete has been committed by Mr Kofs the then Armourer at this place (and) I have traced it I think to the fourth regiment of Cavalry District. The number of swords delivered by him agreeably to his return ~~of records~~ on file in this department do not amount ^{to} within fifty of what were ordered by the Executive to be forwarded by him to your District, and there are sixty two of the number that were placed under his charge not accounted for by him.
