

Annapolis Sept 29 1819

Sir

The duplicate of the Pay Roll, that was made out by the accountant for services rendered by your company of Draughted Militia, in April 1813 at Annapolis, is defective, and will not answer as a voucher to our account against the United States for Militia expenditures filed by our agent W Kerr at the War office - As this account is now under examination at Washington, it is all important that defective vouchers should be supplied by good ones, with as little delay as possible, you will therefore promote the interest of this State by forwarding under cover to me, the Pay Roll that was peaced in your hands for the purpose of paying the troops off by - I will take care that you shall sustain no injury by parting with it as I will procure from the Auditor, previous to sending it on to Mr Wagner, a statement showing that you had
