

Council Chamber Annapolis Sept 26th 1829.

Dear Sir

By a statement made out by me, shewing the number of arms that have been from time to time placed in the hands of the militia (of this) State it appears, that 7260 Stand of Muskets have been loaned to the militia of Baltimore besides 1916 Stand that were received by Col^r Waters from Joseph Henry of Philadelphia, and which still ought to be in Store at Baltimore or in the hands of the militia of that Place, making in the aggregate 9176 Stand leaving 3557 to be accounted for, after deducting the number that have been collected as reported by you -

Will you try to ascertain by enquiry whether there are any arms in Balt. City or County that are not included in your return, and notify me of the result.
