

Council Chamber Annapolis Oct. 21, 1789

I have now the pleasure to enclose you
an order in your favour for two hundred
and twenty nine dollars and fifty cents it being
the amount allowed you for pay & rations
& forage furnished the militia & for cart hire.
The Governour & Council have allowed you for
cart hire the same sum that was allowed
to Bennet Gough Esq. viz two dollars and fifty
cents for a cart Driver & two horses & two dollars
for a yoke of Oxen Cart & Driver. They had
some difficulty in passing your account for
as much as you acted only by Overt.
That question by your not having stated
in the first instance how many horses
& Oxen were employed prevented your
account from being acted on sooner.
