Dear Sir

By a letter which I received from Lemby Jurnp. Esquire, in the last week it appears that he has forwarded to the armory at Annapolis since the 20th February last, 429 Muskets, 2 far touch Bayes, 21 Pistols Wps. of Holsters, 15 side mans swords, and 392 Bayonets. As the returns which you have made to this department do not correspond with this statement I will thank you to make a general return of all the articles received from the agent since the 20th of February last and enclosed it under separate cover so good as to send me copies of my letters to you since Dec. 1877
