I have made out your account upon
the same principles ~~upon~~ on which Mr. Juniper
has been settled by which you will see that
you are allowed by the Executive \$456. for
the arms you have collected, so far as
the Armourer's receipt on file in this
Department goes leaving a balance
due from you to the State of 544 dollars.
It is desirable that the business
the respective Agents should
be brought to a close as soon as possible,
in order that the Executive may be
able to communicate to the Legislature
the commencement of the depopulation
progress that has been made,
and is likely to be made by the Agents
in the collecting of the public arms,
that an estimate may be made
of the loss that the State has sustained
during the late war in that article.
