

Council Chamber Annapolis, Feb 28. 1820

Dear Kerr

His Excellency the Governor returned from
city of Washington on yesterday (and) informs
that the Secretary of war said that he should
be able to attend to you until after the adjournment
next - I have with much trouble been able to
advise Mr Hagner by furnishing him with vouchers
the way he requested to the amount of upwards
40,000. It will I suspect be no difficult matter
to get the account passed as soon as the
Secretary is at leisure - I will however
continue to spare no pains or trouble in
endeavouring to procure the required vouchers
though I think that the vouchers
already furnished would be deemed
sufficient by the Secretary of war
