

Council Chamber Annapolis Mar. 1st 1820.

Dear Sir

There are a number of Muster Rolls wanted for services of the militia performed on the Eastern Shore, and the original vouchers from which you made out the accounts of the contractors. Will you be pleased to inform me whether you have any papers in your possession connected with your late appointment of Accountant and whether you left any in Mr Harwood's possession. It appears by a statement made out by you when you were in Annapolis in November 1813 by direction of Governor Winder that the muster rolls now wanted were in your possession at that period. Nothing less than the muster roll will do at Washington. The vouchers on which this department acted are not deemed sufficient by Mr Wagner.
