and suspended at the war office, on the ground
that there is no proof of your having performed
service as quarter Master - or vouchers or
showing that the Rations were actually issued
to Troops - If you possess the means of furnishing
additional evidence, to what has already been
furnished I will thank you to forward it on
me as soon as possible - the receipts of the
troops for the rations is all that is necessary
with regards supplies.
