Dear Sir

The amount that was paid to you for services performed as Brigadier general from the 9th of June to 17 of August 1814, amounting to \$443. 30 has been suspended at the war office on the ground that there was no evidence of your having been mustered. The vouchers that I see to support that part of the State's claim against the general government was the account which was papered by the Executive. If you can do any thing which will tend to strengthen the vouchers already filed it would be rendering a service to the State you will do so
