(The only vouchers that is wanting to complete those of the 21st Reg^t for Pay of the militia is capt Coppers for services in August 1813 amounting to \$275.56 - If you can procure either the Pay or the muster roll, and will forward it on to me I will thank you to do so - It was not among those that you were so good as to send me - \$156.84 7/16 the amount of the Pay acct. only about \$8000 has been rejected and remains suspended for want of what are called proper vouchers. \$1173 of the whole claim \$293812.13 7/4 not vouchered at all -
