Sir

The gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly at their last session passed a Resolution of which the enclosed is a copy, authorising the Governor and Council to examine into the claims of the respective agents, for the collection of the Public Armes, and to allow them such sum as they may think reasonable & right, and to institute a suit or suits against such of them as may appear to be indebted to the State.
