Dear Sir

Your accounts as passed by this Department, have been filed at Washington, as vouchers to the Maryland Claims, but they are not considered by Mr. Wagner as sufficiently formal ~~or~~ that they were accompanied with that evidence, which shows that the rations charged went into the hands of the militia. It is impossible I should think that Mr. Meredith could have passed the accounts without having in his possession the evidence above mentioned - The vouchers however it seems are not to be found and the State, will in all probability lose in consequence thereof several thousand dollars.
