It has been stated to the Executive  
that an opinion is entertained by a  
number of gentlemen of Caroline  
County that no Magistrate, Levy Court  
& Orphan Court Justice in that  
County can act except those included  
in the last Commission. In other  
words that when a new commission  
is issued it should include all the Justices.  
The departure from the old form was  
made by the late Executive in consequence
